We were checking out the competition and we saw Lorna Staab with Chase. Lo and behold, he was not white-factored. So with a little finessing, a breeding was accomplished.





Bart was trained and shown in Junior Showmanship by his co-owner, Lindsey Laycock and did very well for her. She and Bart earned numerous Best Junior Handlers including the Specialty Shows for the Tampa Bay Area SSC and Mid-Florida SSC. She also put several Reserve wins on him.

He was shown in Julie Desy and Meredith Hector's Virtue Match after their Seminar in Tampa and was awarded Best Symmetry and Balance.

Bart was also shown by both Bill and Irene at various times. Bart picked up his first point at a year and a half out of the Bred-By Class shown by Bill, then another point under Jane Kay. Irene showed him to a Best of Winners win under Lawrence Stanbridge. Bill then picked up a two-point win under George Heitzman on the Florida January circuit. Another memorable win was a four-point major reserve at the Tampa Bay Area Shetland Sheepdog Club Specialty under Patty Widdick-Neale.



Bart always placed as judges appreciated his outline and movement, but being a bi-black he was not everyone's cup of tea. So, with a total of seven points, the decision was made to send him to a handler, Becky Johnson. After working and conditioning him for two months, she put a two point Best of Winners win on him at the Heartland Kennel Club Show.

His next show was at the Sunflower Kennel Club of Olathe Kansas Show with a four-point Best of Winners over 17 dogs and 24 bitches. He finished at the Lochland Shetland Sheepdog Club Specialty under Mrs. Ginny Altman with a five-point Best of Winners win over 24 dogs and 36 bitches.
