
















Member **Spotlight**

Our start in Shelties came in 1966 with the purchase of a pet from a local breeder in Tampa. That dog, Munsey's Shawn, UD, took us to the SSC of Greater Miami, where he won a Specialty High in Trial.

It also took us to a friendship with Don and Dee Strahan, Cypress Shelties. They introduced us to Guy Mauldin, Kismet Kennels, when he came over from Texas for the annual SSC of Greater Miami Specialty with AM CAN CH Banchory High Born, ROM ROMC, where they won Best of Breed. Bill brags he got to sleep with "Banger" that weekend.

We then purchased "Kelly" who became Am Can CH Kismet's High Point, Am Can CDX MHITs, by High Born out of Kismet's Rubaiyyat, ROM. "Kelly" earned a perfect 200 score HIT and also won at a SSC of Greater Miami Specialty. So the journey began.



We bred and co-owned the Second CH OTCH in the breed, Champion/ Obedience Trial Champion Donlyn's



Gypsy Gambler, UD MHITs, "Mark," co-owned and trained by Jean Whitler. "Mark" missed being the first by minutes as number One finished her Championship the same day that "Mark" finished his OTCH. Number One was determined by when they were judged that day. "Mark" was by "Kelly" and Kismet's Solitaire, CD.

Some other special dogs that we have bred and/or shown are: BIS CH Kismet's Centurion, by High Born and CH Kismet's Coquette, who Bill showed at Clearwater Kennel Club for the first of Guy and Thelma Mauldin's many Best in Shows. Another great Kismet dog was CH Kismet's Dynasty, ROM, "Bill", by CH Fairlight Dust In The Wind and Kismet's Bittersweet. We are proud to have co-bred, whelped and raised "Bill" until he went to Guy and Thelma.

We also bred Am Can CH Donlyn's Mylove for Mario, "Baby." "Baby" was by CH Philidove Kismet Heir Borne and Donlyn's Ebony 'Eiress, a "Kelly" daughter. "Baby" finished with three majors, including a Best of Breed and Herding Group One and two Best of Opposite Sex with one BOS at a Specialty.

Others with a special place in our hearts are "Bronco", Am/Can/Bah/Dom Rep/PR/Ven/Int CH Cee Dee's Bravo Of Ashbrook. "Bronco" was by "High Born" and Cee Dee's Annandale. 
